Brixton Beach, is back for another summer - this year inspired by the coasts of Cuba, with pastel-coloured beach huts, leafy palms and copious dunes of sand decorating the roof of the Brixton car park. The drinks will be decidedly Cuban, with a mix of beachside bars serving up tequilas, frozen margaritas and cocktails - as well as two dedicated bars serving Red Stripes and Chandon bubbles. The food offering meanwhile is just a touch more global, including Japanese comfort food from Nanban, ultimate cheesy delights from Mac to the Future, a lot of steak from STAKEhaus and Mexican dishes from Del 74.

If you make it through with your head intact, you'll be able to kick back in the Wonderland bar; filled with flamingo croquet and secret alcoves in which to enjoy experimental cocktails from Smith and Sinclair, guilty pleasure street food from Saucy Chip and espresso martinis on tap. This 12-month popup comes to us from Michelin-starred chef Adam Simmonds and has a very simple idea behind it: after each meal, diners are invited to fill out a small form detailing exactly what they enjoyed, what flavour combos they liked, and what they think might be improved. From that, the menu can be honed and re-honed until it reaches a state of near-perfection, at which point Simmonds will open a permanent restaurant. As it stands, TK is housed in a sleek, marblewashed Soho space, with all bar seating running along the open kitchen.
